The Claimant is to read the following statement in open court on behalf of both parties:

Counsel for the Claimant:

1. My Lord/Lady, I appear for the Claimant in this matter, Miss Sasha Davies.
2. With the agreement of the Defendant, Miss Elha Mai Weston, I make the following statement on behalf of both parties:
3. Miss Davies is a 19-year-old student residing in Wales. Miss Weston also resides in Wales.
4. Between approximately 2022 and 2026 - commencing when Miss Davies was 16 years old - Miss Weston engaged in a sustained campaign of online impersonation, commonly known as "catfishing", of Miss Davies. This impersonation was carried out across seven different social media platforms, including TikTok, Instagram, Facebook, Snapchat, Tinder, Hinge and SoundCloud.
5. Miss Weston created and operated numerous accounts under the fictitious identity "Sophie" and variants thereof, including "Sophie Kadare". Those accounts collectively accumulated more than 100,000 followers and used photographs - and, in due course, AI-generated imagery- of Miss Davies without her knowledge or consent.
6. Through those accounts, Miss Weston communicated with a large number of individuals, including by way of personal and romantic conversations. As a consequence, Miss Davies has been approached on a number of occasions by members of the public who had interacted with the "Sophie" persona and believed they had a genuine connection with her. On one occasion, a man showed Miss Davies messages he had exchanged with one of the fake accounts over a period of months, having believed throughout that he was in a romantic relationship with Miss Davies.
7. Miss Weston accepts and acknowledges that her conduct was wrongful. She further acknowledges the very significant distress and suffering it has caused Miss Davies. Miss Weston deeply regrets her actions and apologises to Miss Davies wholeheartedly and unreservedly for everything she has been put through.
8. As a result of these proceedings, Miss Weston has agreed to the terms of a Tomlin Order, which is before the Court today. By the terms of that Order, Miss Weston has agreed to the making of this statement, to the payment of compensation to Miss Davies and to give an undertaking not to repeat this conduct in the future.
9. With the making of this Statement and Miss Weston's agreement to the terms of the Tomlin Order, Miss Davies is content for this matter to be brought to a close.
