AFTER CONSIDERATION of the Appellants' application for permission to appeal the order made by the Court of Appeal on 12 September 2017 and of the notice of objection filed by the Respondent and of the submissions as to costs subsequently filed

THE COURT ORDERED that permission to appeal be GRANTED on condition that

- (1) neither Appellant shall (or shall be entitled to) seek any payment from the Respondent in respect of its costs of the appeal in this Court in any event; and
- (2) the Appellants provide security for costs in the sum of £85,000 by making a payment into court or by lodging that sum in a bank account in the joint names of the parties' solicitors, or in such other manner as the parties agree.
